
<u>Home</u>

- -Trust but Verify: cell phones, rooms, backpacks
- -Partnership with School Counselors

Processes-Kiss and Ride/Traffic Rules

Students need to be dropped off in the Kiss and Ride line at Door 4 NOT at Door 1

- Arrival: 7:45-7:55 (goal is to avoid the line)
- Dismissal: 2:55
- Bus Lane, Safety and manage frustration

Orange Paper/Magnet




Students: if arriving late to school-must go to their grade level sub school and sign in THEN GO TO CLASS
